To be eligible to umpire you must:

- 1) Be at least 11 years old and have (2) years of Baseball/Softball playing experience.
- 2) Complete an online Umpire Application Form. This is found at www.howellbaseball.org under the “Downloads” link. On this form you will indicate what classroom materials you require. The cost of each item is noted. In addition to the cost of materials, you will also need to bring an additional \$8 with you to the Session One clinic to cover the cost of the room rental for the Umpire Clinics. You can pay with cash or check on the day of the clinic. **The online form must be completed no later than February 22, 2010 to ensure you will have the needed materials at the clinic.**
- 3) Attend (1) Session One classroom clinic and (1) Session Two classroom clinic. **The Thursday and Friday Sessions are specific to Baseball or Softball Umpires. Please make sure you come to the correct one.**
- 4) Pass the Umpire Test – This test will be “Open Book” and available to be taken on-line.
- 5) Attend an On Field Umpire Mechanics Clinic.
